Impacts and Causes of Character Education and Leadership for Students

The cause of leadership and character education must be implemented is because future development needs will support many leaders with character, so that good guidance or education is needed in the present to prepare for the future (Rossi et al., 2021), (Susanto et al., 2021), (Pramita et al., n.d.). At the present time due to the pandemic some schools and universities are holding leadership and character lessons online, and in normal times they will usually get education directly on campus or school through certain events (Supriadi & Oswari, 2020),(Putri et al., 2021). Leadership is the ability that a person has to influence others (Sanjaya et al., 2014), (Songati, 2018), (Hasan, 2018). This means that leadership is a person's ability to influence others to follow the wishes of a leader (Bertarina & Arianto, 2021), (Agustina & Bertarina, 2022). Meanwhile character education, it is really necessary not only in school but also at home, in social environment (Damayanti et al., 2021), (An'ars, 2022), (Anars et al., 2018). The current program is no longer the character of the participants in the age group early to adolescence but also adults (Kurniawan, 2020), (Mathar et al., 2021). Absolute necessary for the survival of this nation (Handayani et al., 2022), (Saputra, 2020a),(AS & Baihaqi, 2020). The competition imagines what will emerge in the following years. Two important aspects in humans are character and leadership, therefore to lead an organization or a place where prospective leaders must have these aspects, from leadership and character education that has been formed, therefore in various schools to campuses leadership education events are held not only at the university level to prepare future leaders or good organizations, but also at the secondary level schools such education

or lessons are also held to educate students' lives to be guided (Saputra, 2020b),(Suwarni et al., 2022).

The notion of character education that: Character is a human anthropological structure, where humans experience freedom and appreciate their limitations (Budiman & Sidiq, n.d.), (PUSPITASARI, n.d.), (PRASETYAWAN, n.d.). In this case, character is not just an action, but a result and a process (Akbar, 2019), (Bonar Siregar, 2021). For this reason, a person is expected to experience his freedom more and more, so that he can be responsible for his actions, both for himself as a person or for developments with other people and his life (Kustinah & Indriawati, 2017), (Sukawirasa et al., 2008), (Hafidz, 2021). Leadership is the ability to obtain work actions with full trust and cooperation (an Environmenta, n.d.), (Yuninda, 2020). In carrying out his leadership, a leader has his own styles (CS, 2019), (Aditomo Mahardika Putra, 2021), (Savestra et al., 2021). Opinion Overton emphasizes the focus of leadership on one's ability to get action from others (Celarier, n.d.), (Cindiyasari, 2017). Now, "being brave" is not enough if you are not equipped with material and broad insights to lead a group, even yourself (Amin, 2020), (SETIYANTO, 2016), (Marlyna, 2017).

Character education has developed in the 2013 Curriculum, of course, it has been implemented by every student who reads the rules at school to say it is in accordance with character development, so this is not only something that is obeyed when we are in that place, but we must also ins till in it that it flows inside so that a better person is formed, and is worthy to maintain an attitude anywhere (BRONDONG, n.d.),(NASIONAL, n.d.). In modern development, belief or failure of an organization is determined by the quality of leadership possessed by people who are appointed or given responsibility as leaders in society or in an organization (Pinem, 2018),(Endang Woro Kasih, 2018),(Mata, 2022). Leaders must have good skills and characteristics as a requirement for a leader in a particular organization (Heaverly & EWK, 2020),(Isnain et al., 2021),(V. A. Safitri et al., 2019). Character education since the beginning of the error of education by experts is a necessary thing. John Sewey, for example, in 1916 said that it is commonplace in educational theory that character order is a general goal and character education in schools.

LITERATURE REVIEW

Character, morals, or personality of a person that comes from the internalization of various virtues that are regulated and underlie the person's point of view, thinking, attitude and way of acting. These virtues are based on a number of values, morals, and such as being honest, acting, distrusting, respectful, respectful of others.

Based on several theories related to character and leadership, some of them are: The transactional theory was "based on reciprocity where leaders not only influence followers but are under their influence as well". Some studies revealed that transactional leadership show a discrepancy with regard to the level of leaders" action and the nature of the relations with the followers. Leadership literature reveals that theories have been refined and modified with passage of time and none of the theory is completely irrelevant. As mentioned earlier, relevance depends on the context in that it is applied. Character refers to a series of behaviors (behavior), motivation (motivations), and skills (skills), including the desire to do the best thing".

Character education as "an effort to educate children to make wise decisions and practice them in their daily lives, so that they can make a positive contribution to their environment". In the education sector, the spirit of a student leader is indeed needed to prepare to be a leader in the future, therefore the suggestion is that the leadership education program is also more intensively implemented evenly in schools, even though they have learned character education since the 2013 curriculum, but it will be more complete, when equipped with leadership education. However, the issue of education that is developing is the low self-confidence of students and the level of character education that has actually declined and only students are obeyed at school is a big question, why are they like that? Based on the survey I conducted above through the questioner, it can be seen how much leadership and character education is needed in the education sector to combat the issue of education which says that students in the past did not have a place to learn leadership materially and in material character as well, so an educational curriculum was formed. character or curriculum 2013 to complement the program in schools and several leadership education programs in several schools and universities to shape the personality and soul of a leader for future leadership candidates. The survey above shows that 87% agree that leadership and character education is needed to foster the spirit of good leadership and shape the character of students much better. Have you ever participated in a leadership education program at your school or college to train your leadership spirit. My question statement which is filled by more than 68% of my friends from outside the campus and on campus, some of them have done the program and some have not implemented it, from the number of students or my friends who support it can be seen that there are still 32% who have not experienced leadership education and experienced character education material to prepare for their future. So that the government must pay attention to this one percentage as a reference that leadership education is needed. Could character education really make the character of the student more polite. My question is that this is 70% approved and not 49% approved. Which means they agree with the question statement that character education in schools and universities can teach students to be more polite, but 49% disagree, which means they believe that there are other sources that can teach us manners and are not based on character education. However, if they want to better understand this, they can learn through character education which is applied as a science. If on campus there is a Leadership Education program at a certain event, if there is a Leadership Training in school, one of the schools that holds leadership training is Sinar Mulia Indonesia School which is located in Surabaya. According to Wahjosumidjo, leadership is someone who has different abilities and has certain traits, namely personality, abilities and abilities. Leadership cannot be separated from the style of behavior or character, interactions with other people and existing situations. The objectives of this leadership training are many, such as:

CONCLUSION
