METHOD



- 4. Do you know LGBT perpretators off campus?


5. Do you agree with the perception that LGBT is a natural thing?

RESULTS AND DISCUSSION


The following section will demonstrate the results of the study that can be seen in table below. The result from the questions given to the students are explained in the below.






Next, for the second question, the writer asked the students if they know about LGBT activities? The result denotes that 69.2% students knew about LGBT activities and the rest did not know about LGBT activities.



Third, the writer asked the students if they had seen LGBT activities on campus? they answered that a few of them had seen LGBT activities on campus, namely 38.5% and as many as 61.5% never found it.



The fourth question is the opposite of the third question whether students have seen LGBT activities outside campus. The answers that students gave are almost balanced, namely asround 53.8% students have seen LGBT activities and 46.2% students never seen it.



And as for the last question, the writer asked the students if they agree about the perception that LGBTQ is normal or abnormal? and most of them answered that they did not agree, namely 69.2% and those who agreed that LGBTQ was normal were 7.7% and the rest were neutral, namely 23.1%.
